The course complies with the requirements of the SAMSA Merchant Shipping (Safe Manning, Training and Certification) Regulations 2013 and the South African Maritime Qualifications code, and the requirements of the Merchant Shipping (Small vessel safety) Regulations, 2011, as amended (Regulation 14(3)(a). MS (NSRV) Regs, 2007. This course will allow entry to Under 25 Ton Vessel category.

The Familiarisation Small Vessel Course encompasses the following SAQA Unit Standards:

- 114923: Demonstrate knowledge of personal safety and survival at sea.

Learners successfully completing this course will:

- demonstrate knowledge of basic safety and survival at sea.
- demonstrate knowledge of the purpose and functioning of safety equipment.
- carry out safety and survival operations at sea.
