Adult Literacy Programme

Low levels of literacy are preventing many South Africans from entering the workplace and formal training opportunities. Siyaloba Training Academy presents an adult literacy programme that addresses the communication and numeracy skills required for learners to:

- Re-enter formal training and development activities:
- Enter the workplace; and
- Achieve workplace success.

This course ensures that learners become equipped with the necessary literacy and mathematical skills to succeed in the workforce - while also developing the life skills needed to reach their full potential. The training is geared towards the adult learner and uses examples that are relevant to the South African learner and local context. As a starting point each learner is formally assessed and entered at the most appropriate point to start their journey to lifelong learning and employment success. Learners undergo a formal diagnostic assessment where skills gaps are identified. Learners are then streamed to one of the following adult working literacy interventions:

Adult Training and Education (AET)

This intervention provides the foundation in English and Mathematics required to support lifelong learning. The course outcomes for each AET level are aligned to SAQA unit standards and successful completion of the course up to AET level 4 provides access to nationally recognised certificates.
