

2 > SAMSA Safety Familiarisation Training

The course complies with the requirements of the Merchant Shipping (Safe Manning, Training and Certification) Regulations 2013 in accordance with the South African Maritime Qualifications Code and the STCW Code '78 as amended, and the requirements of the International Convention on Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers, 1978, as amended in 2010, and STCW Code Regulation A-VI/1, para 1. This course will allow entry to over 25 Ton Vessel category.

The Familiarisation Small Vessel Course encompasses the following SAQA Unit Standards:

- 244006: Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of safety techniques aboard a ship.

Learners successfully completing this STCW accredited course will:

- Understand elementary safety matters, safety information symbols and alarm signals.
- Learn actions appropriate to a shipboard emergency signal in accordance with assigned duties.
- Learn actions to be taken in accordance with established emergency procedures, in the event of encountering a fire on board a ship.
- Know the immediate actions to be taken on encountering an accident or other medical emergency.
- Understand the operation of fire, weather-tight and watertight doors.

Assessment: Learners will be assessed against theory course component as well as complete a compulsory practical water drill.

Certification: Learners successfully completing the course will:

- Receive a SAMSA certificate on the final day of training.
- Receive a TETA certificate following external verification.
